The Beheading of John the Baptist 29th August

John the Baptist was one of those dangerous sorts of people who had an uncanny knack of calling a spade a spade, the sort of person you're a bit afraid to invite to a family function in case they upset everyone. Where most of us get through life trying not to offend anybody, John was the sort of person who could not keep quiet if he saw injustice or wrongdoing. He spoke publicly of Herod's corrupt behaviour, and even when Herod put him behind bars, John continued to speak out. Of course, it was speaking out about Herod's marriage to Herodias that eventually led to his death.

No one is suggesting that we hurt people's feelings by telling them unkind truths, but we are asked to make a stand against bullying, gossip, injustice, oppression, neglect, greed and cruelty. We might not want to tread on toes by speaking up, but if we want our voice to endure beyond the grave, now isn't the time to pussyfoot.

- 3. Click on **Find for a cause to support**. Search for Our Lady of The Assumption—Deptford. Click on the search result to locate our parish.
- 4. Register by Clicking Sign up and support this cause.
- 5. You are ready to start shopping and donate.
- 6. Log into easyfundraising.org.uk every time you want to go shopping.
- 7. Search for the shops you want to buy from, or click **Shop by Category** from the main menu to view the retailers for different category.
- 8. You can also add **Browser Extension** to your computer, iPhone, mobile, or iPad to help you easily locate the retailers when you are searching online without having to be signed into your account. (NOTE: Some shops like Amazon can only be used from easyfundraising.org.uk site.)

Easy Fund Raising tells you how much will be donated to the parish every time you shop. The money raised will be put to wards the Building Fund for parish restoration and maintenance. Easy Fund Raising will paid contributions directly into the parish bank account every quarter. The total will be published in the newsletter for the that quarter.
